Strategies That Work seems to have been written to give teachers easy access to a treasure trove of strategies and activities they can utilize in the classroom. It's broken down into four main parts. Part I: The Foundation of Meaning, Part II: Strategy Lessons, Part III: Comprehension Across the Curriculum, and Part IV: Resources That Support Strategy Instruction (several appendices full of handy resources).

Most of the strategies for understanding directions require some kind of action on the part of the student. In the following strategies, students are actively involved. Targeted Strategy 1: Assess background knowledge. Elicit from students what they already know about the activity before beginning to give directions.

Minute Comprehension This literacy strategy is best exercised early on in a classroom setting, or in a self-taught environment if you're practicing reading comprehension skills on your own. Readers should be given a page of text, or other relatively short passage that they can finish reading within one minute.
